## Jesus Gives Us the Agonizing Crucifix Message of 5 January 2000

In preparing for this newsletter, I prayed that Our Lord would help me to select a message that was timely for all of us to read and meditate on. What I received was far more than I asked for! This message is from the vision where Our Lord gave the Agonizing Crucifix to Barnabas. It contains information we had not been given previously. Barnabas narrates:

Today being the third day of our reparational call, I saw in a vision, Our Lord holding a Crucifix and walking about in a desert. After a while, we met. He said to me, "*Barnabas, take this.*" He then offered me the Crucifix and continued, "*This is your crucified Lord who loves you. He is the one whom you daily crucify. Accept it from Me; carry it always. Show it to the world; let all men have it also. Children, this is what your sins do to me.*"

*You shall make this Crucifix as you see it. I am giving it to you as the instrument and armor which you must all have before the evil man comes to reign in full force. Listen, my children, all the necessary warnings have been given to you. The plans of your enemy have been made known to you. I call you all, not to give you any further warnings, but to prepare and get you ready for the hour. You and all men are to have this Cross as an armor of protection against evil forces that fill the earth now. I promise to perform numerous miracles through it. I will break their*

Catholics should show reverence and honor to the priest because he is the representative of Christ Himself and the dispenser of His mysteries.

The dignity of a priest is higher than any earthly dignity. He has power that the most powerful civil rulers do not possess. The humblest priest by his word alone can call down God upon the altar and convert bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ. He can say to the sinner, "*I absolve you,*" and the sinner's soul is saved from hell. Not even the Blessed Virgin possessed the power to forgive sins or to grant absolution that erases the very guilt of sin.

Even if a priest's life does not correspond with the requirements of his office, we should still give him respect. This we owe to his office.

The priest is "alter Christus," another Christ. Our Lord

## THIRD FRIDAY REPARATION

*This is an overview of the full day program of prayer. The complete program will be available in a separate booklet. Our Lord said this prayer will console the Heart of the Father and greatly diminish the coming chastisements if offered in reparation for the sins committed against the Eucharist and His Most Precious Blood on the Third Friday of every month. You may shorten this program if needed. Each meditation is 12 minutes.*

1. Make a good Confession if possible, or pray the Act of Contrition.
2. **Meditation 1:** The Circumcision of Our Lord. (Read & Meditate; Gen 17: 9-13, Lev 12:3, Lk 2:21, John 3:1-6) **Then pray Our Father & Hail Mary**
3. **Rosary:** For the conversion of sinners and renewal of the face of the earth.
4. **Meditation 2:** Jesus' sweat of blood in the Garden of Gethsemane. (Read & Meditate 12 min; Lk 22:39-46) **Our Father & Hail Mary**
5. **Chaplet of the Precious Blood:** For the forgiveness of sin and the grace of purity in the world.
6. **Meditation 3:** The scourging at the pillar. (Matt 27:24-26, Mark 15:8-15) **Our Father & Hail Mary**
7. **The Roses of the Glorious Reign:** For the reign of peace to come soon.
8. **Meditation 4:** The Crowning with Thorns. (John 19: 1-6, Mark 15:15-20, Matt 27:27-31) **Our Father & Hail Mary**
9. **The Anguished Appeals:** For the release of souls in Purgatory and the conversion of hardened sinners.
10. **Meditation 5:** The Carrying of the Cross. (Lk 23:26-31, John 19:13-17, Mark 15:21-23) **Our Father & Hail Mary**
11. **Stations of the Cross:** For the Pope, the needs of the Church in these her Calvary days and for any special needs.
12. **Meditation 6:** The Crucifixion. (John 19:18-30, Lk 23:32-46, Mark 15: 24-37, Matt 27: 35-50) **Our Father & Hail Mary**
13. **Votive Mass of the Precious Blood:** In atonement for all the sins committed against the Precious Blood of Jesus and the Eucharist in the world and your intentions.
14. **Meditation 7:** The piercing of the Sacred Side of Jesus. (John 19:31-37) **Our Father & Hail Mary**

**Closing prayer and departure in silence.**


**The view of Lake Talquin from our back porch.**

*hearts of stone and pour in my love. I promise also to draw the straying souls closer to myself through this Crucifix.*

*Children, no enemy of My Holy Cross will approach this Cross. On the days of the evil one, you will be able to go freely without any harm through this Cross. Children, accept this gift with love. Let this order not be like the previous others I had made to you. If you neglect this, you will feel it.*

*Listen, My children, my Priest will anoint the first artist to make this Crucifix so that I will fill him with My Spirit and Wisdom...Children, I want you and all men to be consecrated to My Precious Blood...When you have been consecrated, it means that you will fulfill all My appeals to you. You must live the lives of your consecration. All who cannot fulfill all My appeals and orders will not receive this consecration. I will give you a special blessing from Heaven. All who will later consecrate themselves will follow this rule which I have given to you.*

*Children, go back to all My messages given to you in the*

*past. Neglect not even the least among them. Find the neglected appeals and fulfill them. You will be filled with joy if you do so. Make time to read My messages. Have time for meditation. Have time to visit the holy places. Learn to live a crucified life. I am near to lead you.*

*Receive My blessing; let My Precious Blood be a fountain of life to you all. Flow out, purifying water from My Sacred Side, and wash their sins. Let the wounds of your souls be healed. Let My peace be with you all. I love you. I bless you all."* Immediately the vision passed.

calls him, "a city built upon a hill," and "the salt of the earth." He is in the world but not of it. St. Francis de Sales said of priests, "I will close my eyes to their faults, and only see in them God's representatives."

When we meet a priest we should salute him: women and girls should give a slight bow. Men and boys should raise their hats. If they are not wearing a hat, they should offer a slight bow also.

We should never gossip about a priest even if we should notice something we do not like in him; to **calumniate** (*calumny is the uttering, publishing or otherwise relating to others false statements, which are known to be false, which harm the character or reputation of another.*) a priest is a **sacrilege**. (*This term refers to the unbecoming treatment of a person, place or thing which has been consecrated or dedicated to God.*)

We read so much today about sexual misconduct amongst the clergy. In some places it has become so bad that many a diocese are going into bankruptcy. Although many of these accusations are true, there are also some who have an axe to grind with the Catholic Church and are jumping on the bandwagon to do as much damage to the Church as possible. In the process, there are innocent priests who are also being robbed of their good reputations.

One who lays violent hands on a priest may be excommunicated. (*This is the most serious censure of the Church. By excommunication a person is excluded from the communion of the faithful, loses the right of attending divine services, is forbidden the reception of the sacraments, loses the benefit of all public prayer of the Church*

*and may not receive a Christian burial.*)

The chief supernatural powers of the priest are to change bread and wine into the actual Body and Blood of Christ in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass and to forgive sins in the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

A priest who apostatizes, is suspended or excommunicated still remains a priest. He retains the power although not the authority and jurisdiction of the priesthood. For example: he retains the power of offering a true Mass, although he would sin grievously if he did so. He cannot forgive sin, except in the case of the dying. Absolution is a judicial power and needs jurisdiction.

Celibacy is the glory of the Catholic Church. Catholic priests do not marry in imitation of Christ Himself. The priestly vow of celibacy is taken when a man is received into the transitional diaconate. The chief duties of a priest, besides living in celibacy and reciting the Divine Office daily, vary in accordance with the position held. The priest is ordained for the exclusive service of God, that is, for the salvation of souls. His time, his talents and his very life belong to this service.

As shepherd of his flock, the parish priest is responsible to God for the souls committed to his care. Preaching and teaching Christian doctrine is a primary duty. He must visit his parishioners in order to know them and their spiritual needs. He must find out if any new Catholics have moved into the limits of his parish, if all his parishioners have been married in the Catholic Church and if their children attend Catholic schools, if possible, or at least receive religious instruction. He needs to know if they are coming to Mass on Sundays and Holy Days. He must hear their confessions and is always ready to make a sick call and administer the last sacraments. The parish priest must promote the various parochial organizations. He must see that the Church, school, and other buildings or cemetery, if there is one, are all properly cared for. One of the duties closest to his heart should be the custody of the Most Blessed Sacrament on the Altar.

Priests who are not parish priests assist pastors in their manifold duties and works. They teach in seminaries and schools. Following the instruction of their bishop, they attend to all sorts of undertakings that have as their end the glory of God and the salvation of souls.

The parishioners, knowing of all these duties and responsibilities of their priests, should love them all the more, pray for them and assist them in the performance of their difficult task. Parishes are the backbone of the Church.

*“Jesus was going about the towns and villages preaching the Gospel and curing the sick. And seeing the crowds, He was moved with compassion, because they were dejected like sheep without a shepherd. He said to His disciples, “Indeed, the laborers are few. Pray the Lord of the harvest to send laborers into His harvest.”* (Matt 10: 35-37). The laborers are still so few. Christianity is not possible without priests. In many places, good Catholics who know their religion cannot receive the sacraments because there is no priest to administer them. Insufficient instruction for lack of priests causes still others to become indifferent. Many traditionally Catholic areas such as South America, Italy and the Philippines are now suffering from a scarcity of priests.

How can we help to increase the number of priests?

\* First by prayer. Our Lord commanded us to, ***“pray the Lord of the harvest to send forth laborers into His harvest.”***

\* Second, by joining at least one of the various associations of the diocese to promote priestly vocations.

\* Third, by assisting at least one man to answer his call to become a priest.

Jesus has given us His assurance that He will be with us always and that we have but to ***“ask and it shall be given”*** to us. If we lack priests, the fault is entirely our own.

## The Apostolate of the Precious Blood; Our Story

Everyone has been telling me I need to write a book about the amazing blessings flowing from Our generous Lord and His Loving Mother over this Apostolate. In response to your many requests, here is our story. It will continue in each newsletter...

**Monday, July 10, 2006.** I had 8 really big consecrations scheduled all over the US and Canada that month and was scrambling to take care of all the last minute details for each one and still try to sleep as little as four hours a night as well as complete the Great Month of July novenas each day. I looked at the calendar that morning and realized we had to be out of the building we were presently living in exactly three weeks to the day and we had no idea where we would be going. We hadn't even had time to pack a thing yet. I offered a fervent prayer to Our Lady and said, "Mother, your Son's little Apostolate will be homeless in three weeks unless you can find a place for us. You know we have tried and we just can't find anything, and as you can see right now, with all we are doing for your Son, we don't even have time to look."

Three days later, there was a sudden calm in the office. A very deep peace where you could have heard a pin-drop. Just then the phone rang and when I answered, a soft, sweet Southern Belle's voice introduced herself as Candee DeRosier and asked if I was looking for a house to rent. I replied that actually we were. She continued, she was a college student and her father had been trimming back trees to improve the view of the water on their property in anticipation of her brother's wedding which was two weeks away. He tragically fell from the tree and died instantly. The property went into probate and her brother and mother wanted to sell the property because they felt it was cursed. It was all she had of her father's, so Candee petitioned bank after bank to give her, an unemployed college girl, a major loan against the property so she could pay her family their share of the inheritance and still keep her father's house. She succeeded in finding a loan but her financial advisor told her to donate the land quickly because in her position she would lose it anyway so she might as well get a tax write-off for it. He suggested Planned Parenthood as his favorite charity! More trials followed and she finally went to church and prayed offering her father's property to God for His work and begging Him to help her keep it so she would not lose it. She felt a voice in her heart say, "A church group will move into the property and I will do many great things there." She was so excited. She went home and waited

but soon began calling all the churches in the yellow pages trying to find the group who was destined to come. "And then I found you," she finished softly.

The office was pin-drop quiet and I was in shock. Blessed Mother, is this your doing, I wondered?

"How did you find us again?" I asked the soft little voice on the other end of the phone. "In the Yellow Pages, Ma'am" she replied. "We don't have an ad in the yellow pages," I replied, "as a matter of fact, the Apostolate is not listed at all anywhere in the phone book because it is my old personal phone number that the Apostolate is using." "But that is where I found it," She politely but firmly stated. We discussed the number of rooms and the need for office space and everything she said was perfectly and exactly what we needed and more!

Later, I opened the Yellow Pages and *did* find an ad under "Religious Organizations" for our Apostolate! It listed our name and phone number, but the address and website were not correct. The name and phone number were apparently all Our Lady needed to connect this young lady with us. So I rounded up a couple people from the church and agreed to go out and take a look at the property. (Next month: *You won't believe this place!*)

## Pledge a Room for Our Lady

There are still rooms available to pledge in our retreat house. When you pledge a room, you get to select the title of Our Lady you want the room named after and we put a beautiful statue of her image in the room. We upgrade the mattresses, linens, curtains and furnishings and inscribe the title of Our Lady and the donor's name on the door. You then get to bring your friends or family for three FREE retreats, anytime, to come and enjoy your room! Pledge amounts are \$3,500 for a quad room, \$3,000 for a triple and \$2,500 for a double. Our Lady of Guadalupe in a quad room is already pledged, but Our Lady of Fatima (pictured on left) is still available.

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
The second point worth noting was Our Lord's firm demand that this request of His not end up like other requests He has made which were ignored or not acted upon. Barnabas confirmed to me some of the requests made years ago *have not yet* been fulfilled. Our Lord further stresses we are to re-read the messages and fulfill all the neglected requests of His promising that we will be **"filled with joy"** if we do. We have already begun this task and ask for your prayers. We will keep you updated in our next newsletter as to what requests Our Lord has made that were not completed and how you can help us to do so.

The third point was His command that we **"Make time to read My messages. Have time for meditation."** Previous information given to us had been that the messages were not to be printed nor distributed to the public. We have recently discovered the ban is only on the printing of the messages in the diocese of Enugu, Nigeria, and that order does not extend beyond the borders of that diocese.
